Greg Thoren has hosted numerous Field Days over the years and has discussed improvements to his operation, including: increased fertility, decreased inputs, and better return on his bottom line. He focuses his market on direct sale beef, non-GMO corn, and edamame soy beans.

The team will discuss: last year's outcomes; 60-inch row and skip row trials; forage blends crafted for cattle gains; non-GMO, hybrid corn selection; and erosion/ water quality improvement.
