

## Illinois Harvest (IH) permits with Route Authorizations

The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) will make the Illinois Harvest (IH) permit and the required Route Authorization(s) available between September 1<sup>st</sup> and December 31<sup>st</sup> each calendar year for customers electing to run OVERWEIGHT on state routes with agricultural commodities.

To run OVERWEIGHT on state routes, customers will be required to obtain both an IH permit and a 14-day Route Authorization from the Illinois Transportation Automated Permit (ITAP) system. A separate 14-day Route Authorization must be obtained for each being route traveling on to ensure the route is safe for that load. Please note: the route found by the ITAP system is the safest route eligible for the vehicles configurations and weights entered and it may not be the shortest route. For a shorter more direct route, the customer should elect to travel with a legal weight load and NOT an overweight load. If the customer is NOT running overweight, an IH permit and Route Authorization are NOT needed but all posted weight limits on structures must be adhered to.

### Before you start

Before starting to enter an IH permit into ITAP, customers will need to have their Vehicle Identification Card available (see example). Information from this card will be required for entry on the IH permit Application.

## Illinois Transportation Automated Permits (ITAP) system

The ITAP system can be accessed by going to <http://webapps.dot.illinois.gov/ITAP/>. It is recommended you use a modern browser, such as, Chrome, Edge or Firefox. To obtain the IH permit and/or required Route Authorization(s), you can either go to this site and Log On or you can come to the IDOT OS/OW Permit Office walk up window in Springfield, IL and Log On to the computer provided. If you do not have a Log On, you must create one before you can obtain a permit.

If you do not wish to create a Log On, you must contact a permit service to obtain your IH permit and Route Authorization(s). A list of Permit Services that have provided their information to IDOT can be found on the ITAP system under the Oversize Overweight Movements section of the home page.

**Oversize/Overweight Movements**

The Illinois Department of Transportation (IDOT) is authorized by the [Illinois Vehicle Code \(625 ILCS 5/15 - 301\)](#) and the [Permit Office Policy Manual \(2015\)](#) with respect to highways under its jurisdiction that IDOT may, in their discretion, upon application and good cause being shown therefore, issue special permits authorizing the applicant to operate or move a vehicle or combination of vehicles of a size or weight of vehicle or load exceeding the maximum specified in this Act or otherwise not in conformity with this Act upon any highway under the jurisdiction of the state of Illinois. Oftentimes, in order to complete your move, roads NOT authorized to be permitted by IDOT may be necessary. In all such cases involving local jurisdiction roads, permittees MUST obtain permission from appropriate local authorities prior to movement.

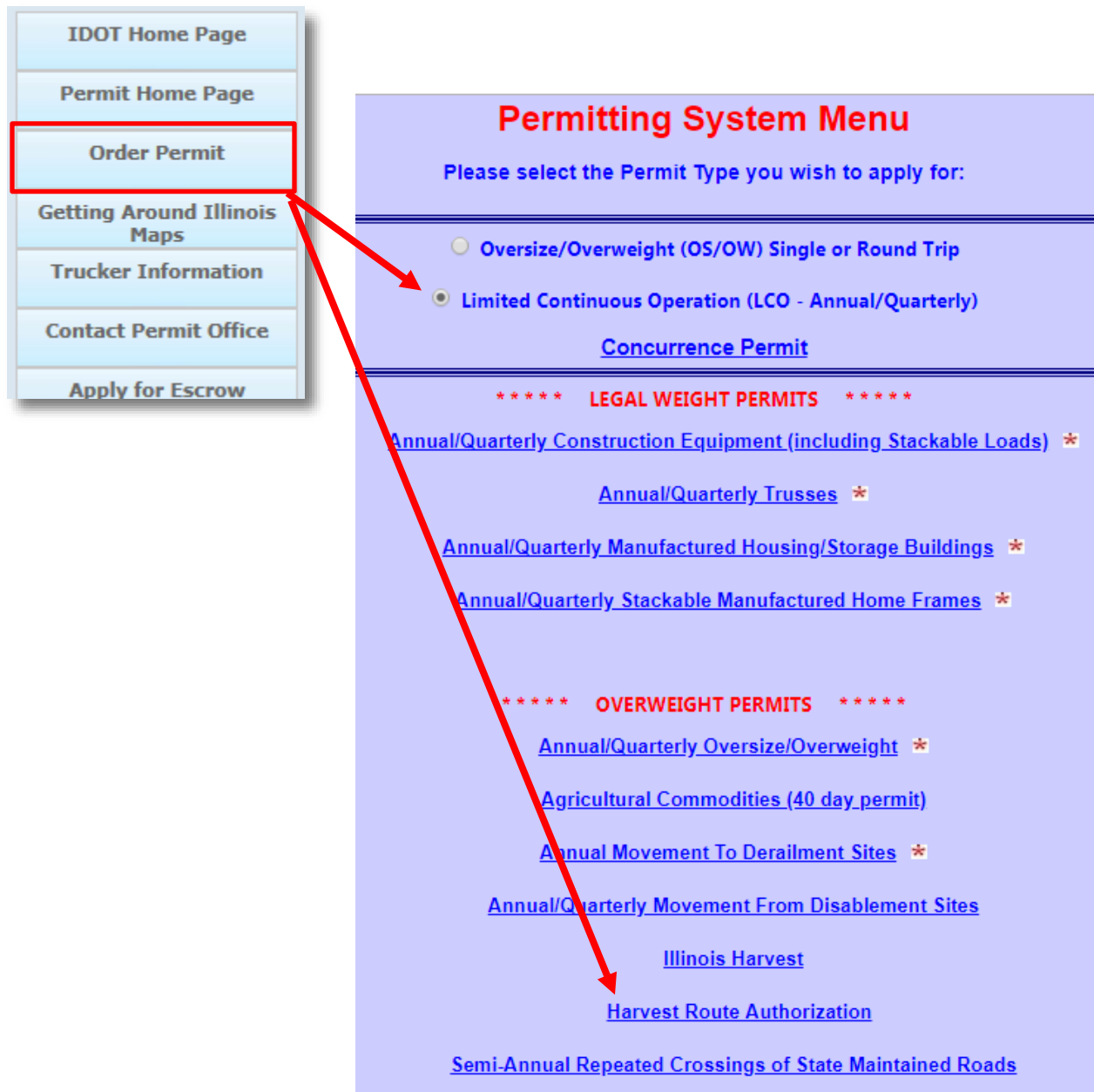
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## Ordering an Illinois Harvest Permit

Once logged in to the ITAP system:

1. Select the Order Permit link from the Left Navigation menu,
2. Select Limited Continuous Operation (LCO – Annual/Quarterly) link from the Permitting System Menu and a list of available LCO permits will open,
3. Select Illinois Harvest found under the Overweight Permits.

Please note: this link will only appear from September 1<sup>st</sup> until December 31<sup>st</sup> each year.



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## Ordering an Illinois Harvest Permit

Once the [Illinois Harvest](#) link has been selected, a screen with a list of provisions applicable to the IH permit will appear. The customer must agree to these provisions by clicking on the **I HAVE READ AND AGREE TO ABIDE BY, THE PROVISIONS STATED ABOVE** statement at the bottom of the provisions list.

**ILLINOIS HARVEST PERMIT**

- **Before traveling with a Harvest permit, the permittee shall obtain a 14 DAY ROUTE AUTHORIZATION FOR EACH ROUTE USED.**  
Failure to obtain a required 14 day Route Authorization could result in your load causing considerable delays and safety concerns for both your load and the motoring public. It may also result in a Violation of your Permit and/or loss of permit privileges with the Illinois Department of Transportation.  
Permit loads are prohibited from crossing Legal Weight and Ton Load Limit Structures.
- The movement of any HAZARDOUS MATERIAL (nuclear, medical or otherwise) is strictly PROHIBITED.
- All movements must be made strictly in compliance with provisions found on the face of this permit, as well as, all provisions found on the OPER 993 provisions form applying as if fully written on the issued permit.
- The permit, 14 day route authorization and OPER 993 provision sheet must be carried in the vehicle and must be available for inspection by police or department officials.
- Movement utilizing this permit is valid on the system of state highways under the jurisdiction of the Illinois Department of Transportation excluding interstate highways.
- This permit is not valid on any highway or bridge posted for a load limit, or on any highway not maintained by IDOT. The right to use highways other than those maintained by IDOT is neither implied nor granted. The permittee must obtain permission from the proper local authority to use local streets or highways or from the Illinois Tollway if traveling over the Tollway system.

I HAVE READ, AND AGREE TO ABIDE BY, THE PROVISIONS STATED ABOVE.

The Illinois Harvest application is like prior years, includes capturing the **Tractor ID number or VIN number**. Validations on the application will ensure the information entered about the vehicle meets limits set for an IH permit and does not exceed them. It will also notify the customer if the configuration entered does not exceed legal limits and no permit is required.

Once all required fields on the application indicated with a red asterisk (\*) are filled out the customer can either:

- Click the **Save** button at the bottom of the page to complete the application later.
  - Once the application is saved the customer can find the incomplete application in their My Permits bin on the Left Navigation panel and:
    - View the Details of the Application
    - Edit the application to complete it
    - Not want the application
- Click the **Submit** button at the bottom of the page to complete the application and issue the IH permit.  
NOTE: The IH permit number will begin with the letter "H".

- The issued IH permit will be emailed to the transmission email associated with that application.

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## Viewing an Issued Illinois Harvest Permit

Once the IH permit has been issued the customer can view the following:

- Details of an IH permit application can be found by going to one of the following three bins:
  - The Search/Print Permit bin on the Left Navigation panel and clicking on Details next to the Issued IH permit
  - The Issued Permits bin on the Left Navigation panel and clicking on Details next to the Issued IH permit
  - The Route Authorizations bin on the Left Navigation panel and clicking on Details next to the Issued IH permit
- Display and/or Print the PDF copy of an issued IH permit that is in effect by going to:
  - The Issued Permits bin on the Left Navigation panel and clicking on Display next to the Issued IH permit.

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## Ordering a 14-day Route Authorization for an Illinois Harvest Permit

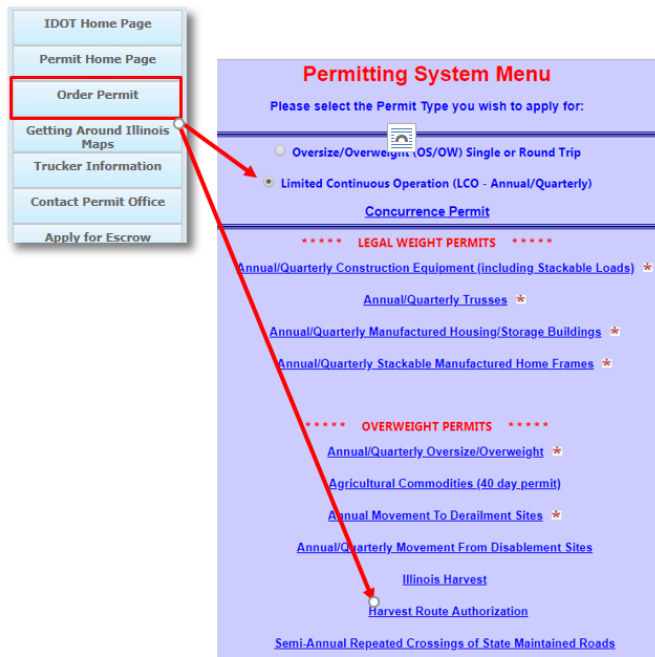
Ordering a 14-day Route Authorization for an IH Permit can be done one of three ways.

1. “Click to Order a Route Authorization” link given as soon as the IH permit is issued.

2. Click on Order Permit, then click on Limited Continuous Operation (LCO – Annual/Quarterly) and then click on Harvest Route Authorization. This can be used when obtaining a required Route Authorization long after the IH permit has been ordered.



The customer will then be prompted to enter their IH permit number so that it can associate the 14-day Route Authorization with the correct IH permit and complete all the routing steps.

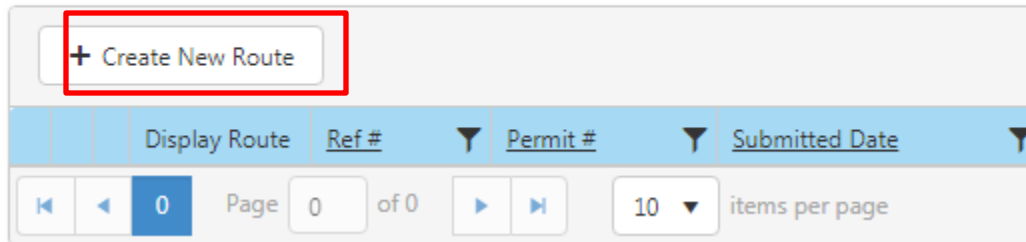
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## Ordering a 14-day Route Authorization for an Illinois Harvest Permit

The customer will be taken to the Route Authorizations grid for that specific IH permit. The customer will then need to click on the Create New Route button at the top of the grid.

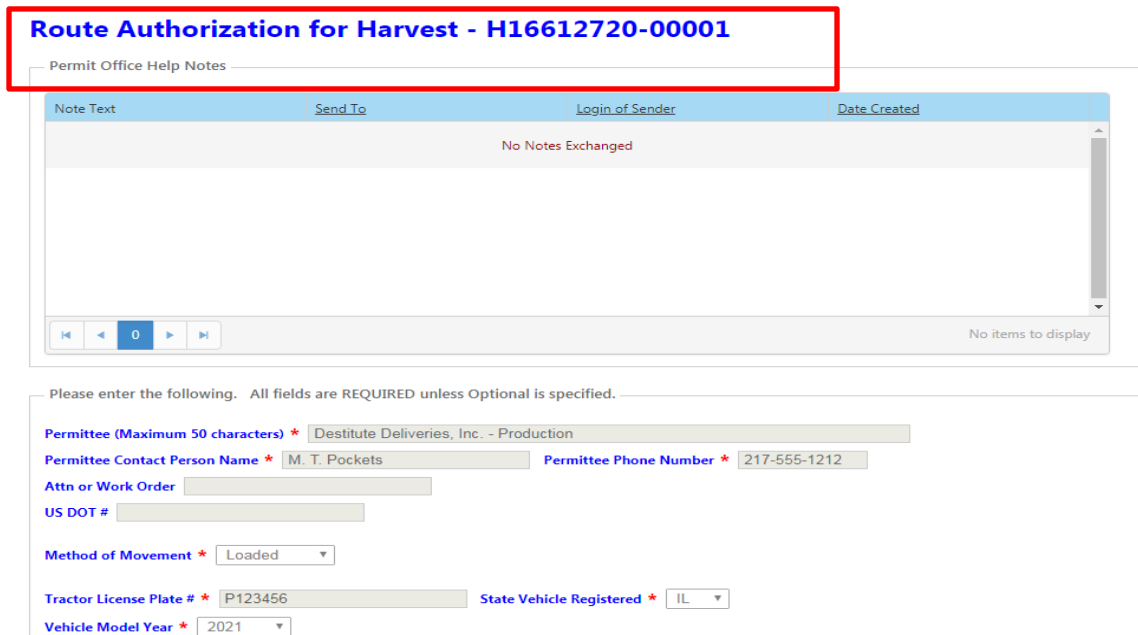

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## Ordering a 14-day Route Authorization for an Illinois Harvest Permit

Most of the fields will be prepopulated from the IH permit ordered previously.

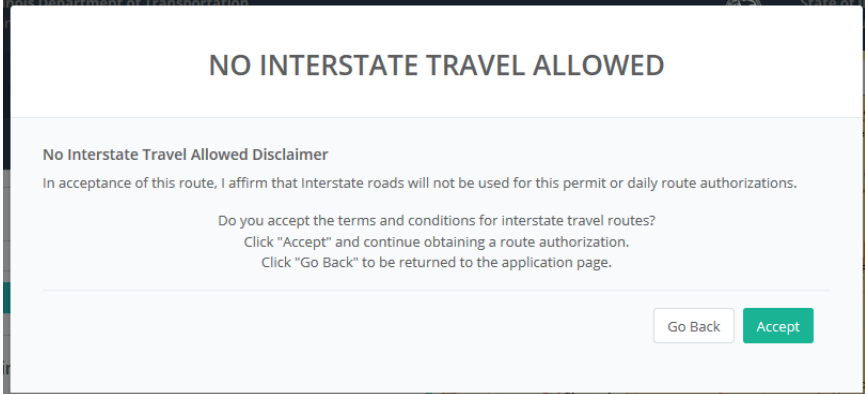
After verification of all information the customer will either click on either the **Save** button to save the Route

Authorization application and complete the routing later or click on **Save and Get Route** button to be taken to the routing page and complete the Route Authorization needed.

When the Routing screen loads, they will have to accept the typical ITAP Routing Disclaimer that all routing customers must accept to obtain a route.

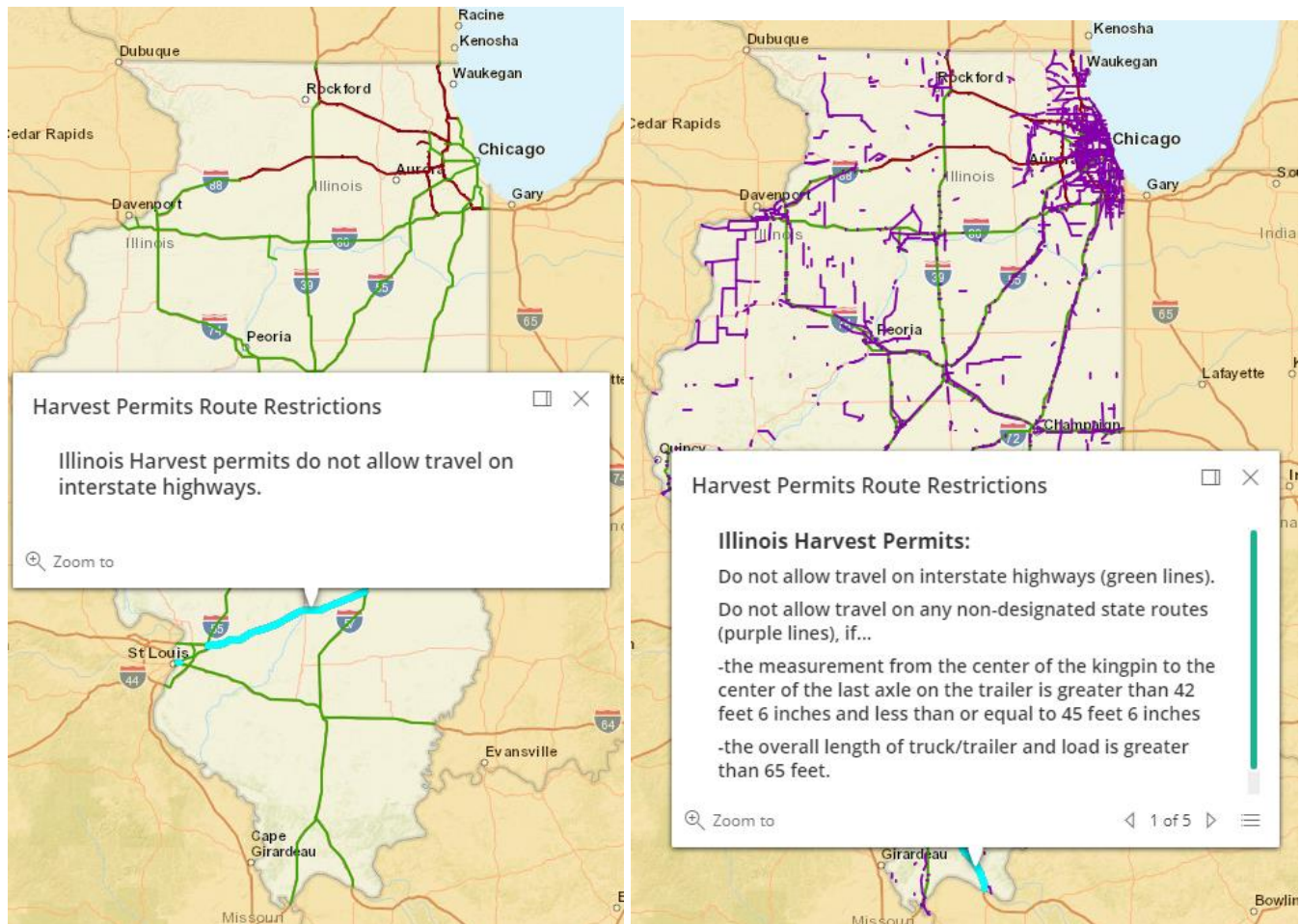


Then they will then be presented with a second pop up that

reiterates that these loads are prohibited from traveling on Interstates. If they are unable to comply with the required method of travel they need to select the **Go Back** button and they will be returned to the application page and no Route Authorization will be issued. If they can comply they need to select the **Accept** button to continue on to selecting the route.

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## Ordering a 14-day Route Authorization for an Illinois Harvest Permit

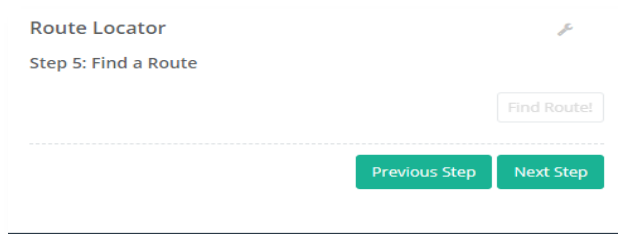


All the same Routing functions are available to them to find an acceptable route including the use of Waypoints. The system *should* prevent them from being able to route on any interstate, as well as, on any Non-Designated route if the legal length of the king pin, trailer or overall length exceeds legal length.

The map has been enhanced with new layers to show which roads are acceptable for IH permit to travel and if an unacceptable road is clicked on the customer will be given one of the two popups shown above.

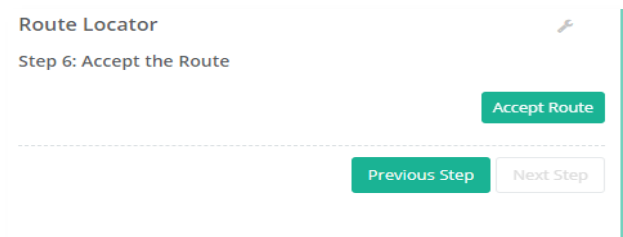

### Accept Selected Route and Conditions

This permit does not authorize travel on any local jurisdiction roadways, toll roads, local structures on state jurisdiction roadways listed in the route shown on this permit.

By acceptance of this permit, the permittee acknowledges prior to movement on or across any local jurisdiction roadways, toll roads, local structures on state jurisdiction roadways listed in the route shown on this permit, they must obtain permission from the entities having jurisdiction over these roadways or structures.

The County name listed after the route is for information purposes only. It does not imply that the county has jurisdiction over that route.

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## Ordering a 14-day Route Authorization for an Illinois Harvest Permit

Once on the Route Authorization Acceptance page customer can choose to:

- Cancel the Route Authorization – to do this the need to click the **Cancel** button. When doing this the customer will be:
  - Returned the customer's Route Authorization grid
  - The route they just created will be in a Not Submitted Status
    - If they choose to go back to the routing page later, the system saves their origin, destination and any waypoints entered but it will have to recheck their routes to ensure no restrictions have been added to their desired route before the route authorization can be issued.

- Accept the Route Authorization – to do this they will need to click on the **I Accept** button. Once they do this:
    - The customer's screen will show the issued Permit Number confirmation message
- 
- The customer will be returned to their Issued Permits/Route Authorization bin
  - An email with attached PDF will be sent to the transmission email address associated with the application.

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## Viewing a 14-day Route Authorization for an Illinois Harvest Permit

To view all Route Authorizations, issued or saved, that are associated to a specific issued IH permit the customer can click on the Route Auths button next to the IH permit it is associated with, in either the Issued Permits bin or in the Route Authorizations bin located in the Left Navigation Panel.

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## Requirements for 14-day Route Authorizations:

- An IH permit is required to obtain a 14-day Route Authorization for every route traveled on.
- If the same vehicle will be used on the same route repeatedly that same day, only the one weekly route authorization per IH permit is needed for that 14-day period.
- If the same vehicle will be used on multiple routes that day, then a Weekly Route Authorization is needed for each route that will be traveled in that 14-day period with that vehicle. The customer is only able to obtain a 14-day Route Authorization to start on the first day of travel. They are not able to obtain a Weekly Route Authorization in advance (i.e. they can't order a month's worth of RA's on a single day.)
- The IH permit, Weekly Route Authorization and OPER 993 shall be carried in the cab of the truck making the move.
- All movements shall be made strictly in compliance with the General Provisions on Page 3 of the issued permit, as well as, all the provisions found on the OPER 993 Special Vehicle Movements Permit Provisions. Including, but no limited to a rotating, oscillating or flashing amber light must be mounted on the load to be seen 500 feet in all directions.
- The newest OPER 993 can be found on the ITAP home page <https://webapps.dot.illinois.gov/ITAP/>.
- 14-day Route Authorizations are only giving permission to use routes that are under the State's Jurisdiction.
- Local permission to travel on routes under a local entity's jurisdiction shall be obtained from that local entity prior to moving.
- Illinois Toll Authority permission to travel on routes under the Illinois Toll Authority's jurisdiction shall be obtained from the Illinois Toll Authority prior to moving.

Pursuant to Section 15-301(e-1) of the Illinois Vehicle Code (the Code), this is your Harvest Permit. This permit shall apply to the registered vehicle identified on this permit that is eligible to obtain permits under this Section, including vehicles used in private or for-hire movement of divisible loads of agricultural commodities during the harvest time period. This permit along with the OPER-993 and 14 Day Route Authorization must accompany the load.

All other restrictions that apply to permits issued under this Section shall apply to this permit during the time period.

Vehicles operating under an Harvest Permit shall not be in violation of the Code's Section 3-401 (d-3).

Harvest Permits are only valid on Federal and State highways under the jurisdiction of the Illinois Department of Transportation.

### General Provisions

All movements must be made strictly in compliance with OPER 993 Special Vehicle Movement Permit Provisions Form applying as if fully written herein.

Pursuant to 5/15-301(f) of the Illinois Vehicle Code, the original permit and the form OPER 993 are required to be carried in the vehicle or combination of vehicles to which it refers (an electronic version is acceptable) and shall be open to inspection by any police officer or authorized agent of any authority granting the permit, and no person shall violate any of the terms or conditions of such permits. This permit along with the OPER-993 and the 14 Day Route Authorization shall accompany the load.

1. This permit grants authority only for the operation of the vehicle specifically indicated in the application; substitution of any vehicle or load will render the permit null and void.
2. This permit has been issued by the Department with the understanding that: (1) All legal requirements concerning operational authority imposed by the Illinois Motor Carrier of Property Act or the Interstate Commerce Commission have been complied by the applicant; (2) The vehicles have been properly licensed in accordance with Illinois law for the gross weight being transported; (3) Both the driver and owner of the vehicle to be moved have met all financial responsibility requirements imposed by law and; (4) The operator is properly licensed. When this permit has been acted upon by the permittee such action shall be deemed an unequivocal allegation by the permittee that all operational, licensing and financial responsibility requirements have been complied with.
3. Maximum allowable width and height are 8 feet 6 inches and 13 feet 6 inches respectively.
4. Axle weight tolerances do not apply. Penalties for exceeding the allowed weights shall be assessed in accordance with Section 15-113.2 of the Illinois Vehicle Code for all weight in excess of the permitted weights.
5. The legal maximum gross truck weights contained in Section 15-111 of the Illinois Vehicle Code apply.
6. The movement of any HAZARDOUS MATERIAL (nuclear, medical or otherwise) is strictly PROHIBITED.
7. If ANY MOVEMENT utilizing this permit exceeds the specified dimensions and/or weights specified by this permit, then said permit is no longer valid.
